

3) THREE Ways for bringing Money to China.

I. Western Union Money Transfer - *It's easy to send and receive money via this way.*

II. Travel Check

You need to consult your local bank for related information, such as how can you withdraw the money in China and the additional charge coming along with.

III. International Money Transfer

When you arrive in China, you can apply a local bank card using your passport, and then you will be able to do international transactions (if activated) in a more economical way. You will find more information about international rate and functions through the local bank.

ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS NEEDED

1) Admission Documents issued by the university:

Admission Notice and JW 202 form (*For students with X1/X2 visa*)

Printed e-offer (*For students with L visa*)

No need to bring any admission documents (*For students with L visa who don't have admission package or e-offer*)

2) Physical Examination Certificate

(*For students whose study length is more than 6 months*)

3) Academic Documents of Highest Education, including transcripts and graduation certificate

(*For degree programme students*)

4) Passport
5) Passport Photos

(8 copies of the photo, the same size as in the passport)

6) Temporary Residence Permit.

(For students who live on campus or hotel, the university or the hotel will issue you a temporary residence permit; for students who rent house outside campus, these students should get it from the local Public Bureau.)

7) International Insurance Card

(For students who have purchased the international insurance in their own countries)

VISA & RESIDENCE PERMIT
1) VISA

Visa Type	Visa Explanation	Material Required
X1 Visa	study period of more than 6 months	Admission Notice; JW202 Form
X2 Visa	study period of 6 months or less	Admission Notice; JW202 Form (if applicable)
L Visa	Tourist visa	No documents issued by the university is required

- *Extra documents might be furnished upon the authority's request*

 ✓ **X1 visa**

Students with an X1 visa who plan to stay in China for more than half a year must obtain the Residence Permit within 30 days of entry in China. Those who exceed this time limit are considered illegal residents. A physical examination is required when applying for the Residence Permit.

 ✓ **X2 visa**

Students with an X2 visa are not required to hold a residence permit. "Intended days of stay" in the visa decides their days of stay in China.

 ✓ **L visa**

Students who come to China with an L visa must obtain an X visa before applying for their residence permit, or else they can only stay in China only within the valid period designated in their L visa.

2) RESIDENCE PERMIT

International students have to apply the Residence Permits within 30 days after entering China and

finishing their registrations.

- ✓ For students who live on campus or hotel, the university or the hotel will issue you a temporary residence permit, and the university will provide help for these students to get the residence permit.
- ✓ For students who rent house outside campus, they should go to the Public Bureau within 24 hours after enter China. And the public bureau will give details about the residence permit processing.
